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- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plan or specifications before with the application, and all to in the execution hereafter otherwise required.
- (2) That the external finish of the proposed structure meets that of the existing house. (This requirement refers to visual quality).
- (3) That the requirements of the Urban Authority be complied with in respect of drainage disposal and water supply. (In the interests of health).
- (4) That the existing structure shall be separated from the house on the north side by a suitable fence, so as to prevent the possibility of the spread of the disease. (In the interests of health).
- (5) That the Urban Authority approval shall be obtained for any construction of such structure shall be obtained in the development.
