- (I) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the amplication, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That suitable "hard standing" for car parking space be provided on the site to the extent of one car-space per teacher plus space for two visitors cars.
- (3) That Building Mys-Laws Approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of a period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in mission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.
