In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order E/347/67 dated 12th April 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for

Liquids Ink Factory at Palmerstown.

for the following reasons:-

1. The plans lodged do not indicate sufficient details of drainage disposal to satisfy the Planning Authority that serious pollution of the adjoining watercourse and River Liffey would not occur.
2. Sufficient details have not been given in the application as to the extent of the development proposed, viz. total extent of new buildings envisaged and nature of manufacturing process and materials to be used therein.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary (Planning Appeals Section) Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
