In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/319/67 dated 1st June 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing outline permission for: Bungalow at Friarstown, Bohernabreena

for the following reasons:-

- (1) In view of the method of drainage proposed the site is considered inadequate to suitably contain the proposal and would be injurious to the amenity of the adjoining dwelling.
- (2) Existing development and location of adjoining septic tanks are not shown on the lodged plans.

Note: You are advised to consult with the Dublin Sanitary Authority, 9 Parnell Square, with regard to the above two considerations.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the applicant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, (Planning Appeals Section), Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for outline permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
