AND WHEREAS

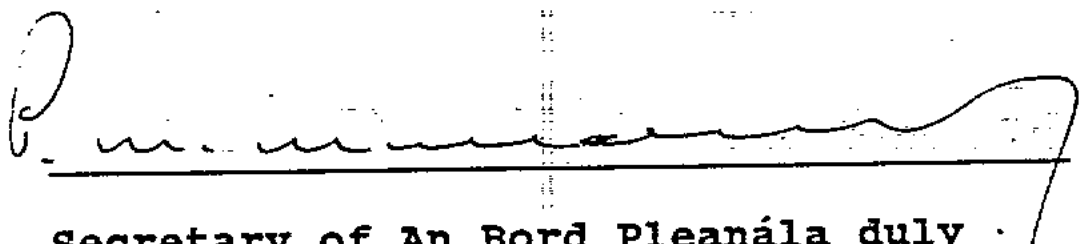

APPLICANT Esker Park Ltd.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the
Cc Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ A/1292/82, dated 25/5/'82
decide to refuse: ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ PERMISSION ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~

For Proposed 14 houses at site No.'s 115 to 128 at Esker North, Lucan.

for the following reasons:

1. A major portion of the site of the proposed development is located on land which was shown on lodged plans as part of the Local Distributor Road network for the area. These plans were approved by the Planning Authority and by An Bord Pleanala and the major portion of the site was conditioned to be ceded free of charge to the Council.

The proposed development would be in conflict with the applicant's earlier development proposals and the conditions attached to earlier permissions on foot of which the estate has been developed and would be seriously at variance with the proper planning and development of the area. The site is seriously affected by a road proposal as shown on applicant's earlier drawings.

2. The remainder of the site outside of the land required for road purposes was shown as public open space on the applicants earlier applications for permission. These lands were conditioned to be reserved and developed as public open space and made available to residents. The proposed development would be in conflict with the applicant's earlier development proposals and conditions attached to earlier permissions on foot of which the estate has been developed and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the residents in the estate.

3. There are no public piped sewerage facilities available to serve the proposed development.

4. The proposed development would be premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of piped sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.

Pleanala, Holbrook House, Holles Street, Dublin 2 and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and
has not been withdrawn An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first
instance.
