APPLICANT Kings Hospital School

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1263/67 dated 22nd November 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act to grant an outline permission for:

Development of land for School Buildings and Grounds at Brooklawn, Palmerstown

subject to the following conditions:-

- (I) That no development works shall commence until detailed plans, including that of the entrance from the main Dublin/Lucan Road, have been submitted to and approved by the Planning Authority.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, outline permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the outline permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for outline permission as if it has been made to him in the first instance.

I am to refer to your letter of the 13th March last regarding planning permission in connection with above and to state that before a decision on the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning & Development) Act, 1963 the following information must be submitted:-

- (1) Details (including levels, pipe sizes, sections and gradients, etc.) of the proposed means of drainage disposal from the proposed development into the adjacent public main sewer.
- (2) Details of the proposed school population and total amount of drainage effluent to be expected from the development into the public main sewer, if this is found to be feasible.
