In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned /.ct the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/140/67 dated 3rd May 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act to grant an outline permission for:

Factory development at Gallenstown and Ballyfermot Upper

subject to the following conditions:-

- (I) That no constructional work takes place until detailed drawings have been submitted to and approved by the County Council under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963.
- (2) That a financial contribution be paid by the applicant to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of future provision of public piped sewerage in the area of the proposed development and which facilitates this development; the amount of this contribution to be assessed on submission by the applicant of detailed plans for approval.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, outline permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the outline permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.
