APPLICANT David Allen & Sons Ltd.,

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1583/66 dated 3rd March 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

Advertising Panel (including advertising structure at Longmile Road, Drimmagh

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The proposed advertising panel would endanger public safety by creating serious traffic hazard due to obscuring the view of drivers in approaching traffic of the forecourt, service facilities and entrance to the existing Volkswagen Garage.
- (2) The proposed advertising panel would endanger public safety by creating serious traffic hazard due to its location near a junction of a heavily trafficked trunk radial road on the city outskirts.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary (Planning Appeals Section) Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
