In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1552/66 dated 24th February 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

Canavan Sales Park at Rathcoole

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The development would prejudice the position in respect of the unauthorised flat conversions carried out to the adjoining Globe House, in that the site of the proposal was originally shown as part of the grounds attached with Globe House on an application for permission to convert same into seven flats and for which permission has been refused by the Planning Authority by Order No. TP/1387/65, dated 5th October 1965.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary (Planning Appeals Section) Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
