APPEAL by Laurence Kelly of The Kestrel House, Walkinstown Cross, County Dublin against the decision made on the 14th day of May, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the retention of an illuminated sign at The Kestrel House, Walkinstown Cross, County Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1982, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said sign for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE
