When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.

- (4) That a suitable protective railing, designed so as not to obscure vision at the junction with Whitechurch Hoad, be erected on top of the proposed retaining wall and parapet walls adjoining the Whitechurch River, in the interests of public safety.
- (5) That the plots of land, coloured blue on the plan, No. C.P. 435, be reserved for improvement of Whitechurch Road.
- (6) That the frontage lengths be equalised as between sites number 5/6 and 11/12, by adjusting the angle of the diagonal division fence between Nos. 5/6 and 11/12, respectively, in the interests of proper Planning.
