Conditions:

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer shall be ~~strictly~~ adhered to in the development.
- (3) That the external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing dwelling.
- (4) That Building Bye-Laws Approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for conditions:

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the ~~application~~ ^{specification} and effective control maintained.
- (2) In the interests of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
- (3) In the interest of visual amenity.
- (4) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
