In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health Distric of Dublin, did by order <u>(1933/66</u>, dated <u>10th Sctober, 1960</u> make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act to grant a permission for:

subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) That the development be cardied out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, sove as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That the derelict cot ... e chisting on the site be removed before any constructional work is comenced in connection with the proposal.
- (3) That details of the front boundary wall be submitted to the Council for appro al before election.
- (1) That the external finishes including the roof harmonise in colour and texture with existing development in the area. (Conditions 2, 3 and 4 reter to visu 1 amenity).
- (5) That the entrance be recessed a minimum dist nce of 15' from the public road bounds y of the site. (This requirement refers to vision at acless to the public ro.1).
- (6) That Building Bye-Laws Approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval be observed in the development.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Lecal Government against this decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Evernment will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
