In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/956/66 dated 14th October, 1966 make a decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act refusing approval for:

Bridge and culvert to streams at Whitechurch Road, Rathfarnham

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The design details in respect of the bridge structure do not satisfy the Engineering requirements of the Planning Authority in respect of the design of foundations and abutment walls.

NOTE: ~~It is recommended that~~ The applicant, or his adviser, should consult with the Council's Engineering Department before re-submitting plans for approval.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been drawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for approval as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
