I return herewith plan, letter and copy of public notice received from you on 26th July in connection with proposed two-storey dwelling. In your letter of application under the Planning Act, you state that you are applying for permission, whereas the documents which you submitted are incomplete for this purpose. In accordance with the Permission Regulations 1964, your application should have included:-

- (1) Detailed plans of the proposed structure,
- (2) Specification of the materials to be used, etc. in the proposed work, and
- (3) Site plan indicating accurately the location of the proposed dwelling.

If you intend this application as one for Outline Permission, you will require site plans only, but these should be properly drawn with outline of site and exact location of proposed house clearly indicated. - see Form enclosed w.

Please note that the County Council cannot deal with the matter any further until a fresh application has been received which complies with the Regulations. For your guidance, I am enclosing memorandum in regard to the making of applications under the Planning Act.
