  - (5) That detailed drawings of the front boundary wall and entrance gates be submitted to and approved by the Council before same are erected. (Conditions Nos. 4 & 5 refer to visual emenity).

(6) That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such If there is no appeal to the Minister for development against this decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of . the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in ascordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.
