for the following reasons:-

- (1) The area of the site does not meet with the density requirements in this area which is one house per five acres.
- (2) There are no piped services available.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, (Planning Appeals Section), Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for outline permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
