In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/123/66 dated 21/4/66 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

Stores at Ballymount Little

for the following reasons:-

- (1) Piped drainage services are not available to serve the proposal.
- (2) The proposal to provide septic tank drainage is not acceptable.
- (3) The proposer has not indicated the specific use for which the stores building is intended.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary (Planning Appeals Section) Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
