MEMPHIS, TENN
- (1) That the Commission has received the report and has completed its investigation and has determined that the Commission has no evidence to substantiate the charges of discrimination.
  - (2) That the Commission has advised the Negroes that they should place applications for membership in the NAACP and that they should not be subjected to any form of discrimination on the basis of race or color.
  - (3) That all information received from the NAACP and the Negroes has been reviewed and the Commission has determined that a program of investigation for the NAACP area at the time shall be drawn up and submitted to the NAACP for its consideration and approval.
