Section 1.01 - General

The Board of Directors shall have the authority to manage the business of the Corporation and to exercise all the powers and authority vested in the Corporation by its Charter and the laws of the State of New York.

In the interests of the Corporation and its stockholders, the Board of Directors shall have the authority to take any action which it deems to be in the best interests of the Corporation.

In the interests of public safety and the avoidance of traffic hazards, the Board of Directors shall have the authority to take any action which it deems to be in the best interests of the Corporation.

In order to comply with the provisions of the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966, the Board of Directors shall have the authority to take any action which it deems to be in the best interests of the Corporation.

Section 1.02 - Officers
