In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/35/66 dated 6/4/66 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act, refusing permission for:

Dwellinghouse at Thomastown Road, Belton Estate

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The layout now proposed for this portion of the Belton Estate development with frontages of approximately 27' is at variance with the layout approved by order No. TP/2301/63, dated 24/1/1964, with 35' site frontages.
- (2) A reduced standard of layout is undesirable fronting to Thomastown Road which is the main dual-carriageway estate road.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
