CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the applicant indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property.
3. That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.
4. That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense if so is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair of any and for the repair replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.
5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users at lighting of this or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.
6. That details of the precise location of the bus shelter be agreed on site with the Area Engineer (Roads Maintenance) Dublin County Council.
