In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order 11/3/66 dated 11/3/66 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

Concrete Plant at Salrothery, Tallaght

for the following reasons:-

- (i) The establishment of a concrete mixing plant on this site would result in serious injury to the amenity of the surrounding area by reason of appearance and also traffic and noise generated therefrom.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary (Planning Appeals Section) Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
