BACK.

CONDITIONS:

- (1) Subject to any amendment arising from the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, the Chief Medical Officer, the Engineering Department and/or the building bye-laws, the development to be carried out in conformity with the drawings and specification to which this application relates. Any requirements of the Chief Fire Officer and Chief Medical Officer to be complied with. Approval under the building bye-laws to be obtained and all conditions of approval to be observed in the development. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of development).
- (2) Surface water must be discharged into the existing surface water drainage system in the hospital grounds. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of development).
- (3) There must be no alteration of existing gateway at Orwell Road without the prior approval of the Corporation. (To prevent the creation of a traffic hazard).
- (4) All trees and shrubs on the site not directly affected by the proposed development to be preserved. (To protect the amenity of the area).
