That before development commences approval under the Building Bye Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development. 3. That before development commences, the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. 4. That adequate and safe access be provided to the existing public road. 5. That an adequate and satisfactory landscaping scheme particularly with regard to the site boundaries be submitted to and approved by the Council after consultation with the Council's Parks Department. 6. That a financial contribution in the sum of £100.00 be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained. 2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1972-1984. 3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard. 4. In the interest of safety. 5. In the interest of visual amenity. 6. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
