APPEAL by Tiernan Homes Limited of 15A, Clyde Road, Ballsbridge, Dublin against the decision made on the 8th day of April, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse permission for the retention of a temporary advertising sign at the junction of Grange Road and Ballinteer Avenue, Rathfarnham, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1982, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said advertising sign for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The retention of the sign would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard as it would be likely to distract road users in close proximity to the heavily-trafficked and substandard junction of Ballinteer Avenue with Grange Road.
