In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ **A/923/82** dated **8th April, 1982** decide to refuse:

For **proposed temporary access to previously approved industrial development**

at Lucan Road, Palmerstown.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard in that it would generate additional traffic turning movements on the heavily trafficked and inadequate National Primary Route.
2. The development would materially contravene Condition No. 13 of Order No. PA/1623/80 (TA 1061) which states "that no access be provided from the site to the Lucan Road either directly or indirectly. Vehicular access to be via the proposed road connection to the south. No development to take place until access is available for the existing Irishtown Road to the southern limit of the applicant's site. The applicant to consult with the Roads Engineer in regard to this matter."
3. The development would cause interference with the construction of the Palmerston/Ballydowd Road, the construction of which is imminent.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn An Bord Pleanála will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
