In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order TP/1891/65 dated 7.10.65. make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

Proposed house at The Slade, Saggart.

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The necessary legally binding Indenture sterilising the requisite area of land, as indicated on the lodged plans, has not been submitted.
- (2) The position on the site in which it is proposed to erect the bungalow has not been indicated on the lodged plans. This should not be less than 35' from the existing road boundary.

Note. More favourable consideration may be given to this proposal when the above requirements have been complied with satisfactorily.
