In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order TP/2377/65 dated 16.12.65 make a decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act to grant a permission for:

New buildings, Crushing and Washing Plants at Quarries and Sandpits,

Ashfarrell, Brittas.

subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with application (22.7.65) and with the revised application (20.9.65) and with the drawings and letter lodged on the (22.11.65)

9 Note. The applicants should be advised to discuss the proposal with the

- (1) Electricity Supply Board, as that body may have some control over the catchment area of the ~~above-mentioned~~ stream.

- (2) ~~That~~ The applicants should also be advised to ensure that no unreasonable use of the water in the adjoining stream be made, and that the applicants acquire legal right for any use of such water in excess of that to which they may be entitled as riparian owners.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.
