CONDITIONS:

(1) Subject to any amendment arising from the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, the Chief Medical Officer and/or the building bye-laws, the development to be carried out in conformity with the drawings and specification to which this application relates. Any requirements of the Chief Fire Officer and Chief Medical Officer to be complied with. Approval under the building bye-laws to be obtained and all conditions of approval to be observed in the development. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of development).

(2) The entire premises to be used only as a single dwelling unit. (To prevent unauthorised development).

(3) A boundary fence of substantial construction, at least 18" high, to be preserved along the frontage of the site to Shelton Grove. (To preserve the amenities of the area).
