With reference to your planning application received here on 3/2/82 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you, that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The applicant should submit detailed drawings of the buildings and site including a block plan at 1:500 scale indicating access/loading and unloading facilities and proposed car parking as well as proposed landscaping. Elevation drawings are also required.
2. The applicant should indicate the precise nature of the use of the buildings, including what goods it is intended to store in the buildings and the likely generation of traffic.
3. Details of the proposed drainage of the site should be submitted together with staff members, sanitary accommodation etc.
