CONDITIONS:

- (1) Subject to any amendment arising from the requirements of the engineering department and/or the building bye-laws, the development to be carried out in conformity with the plans and specifications to which this application relates. Approval under the building bye-laws to be obtained and all conditions of approval to be observed in the development. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of development and to prevent unauthorised development).
- (2) The entire premises to be used only as a single dwelling unit. (To prevent unauthorised development).
- (3) A boundary fence of substantial construction, at least 18" high, to be preserved along the frontage of the site to Dodder Park Road. (To protect the existing amenities).
