- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications lodged with the application.
- (2) That the proposed structure shall not be used for any purpose other than a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the building herein as a wharf.
- (3) That the external finish, basement in outline and features with the subject building be as shown.
- (4) That building bye-law approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
