Conditions

That the development shall be carried out in accordance with the plans and specifications lodged with the applicant subject as in the conditions hereunder otherwise stated.

(2) That the proposed house be set back a minimum distance of 15.5' from the existing street boundary and the setting out of the house shall be agreed with a representative of the Council's Roads Department.

(3) That the necessary land shall be reserved for road improvement purposes in accordance with the requirements of the Roads Department.
