Development of Mining Methods at Public Road, Tucson
 Paper No. 7700-70

Conditions

- (1) That the development to be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plan and specifications lodged with the application, and as set out in the conditions hereunto annexed, is required.
- (2) That a review of the plan for access will require to be submitted to and approved by the Council before any work is commenced on the site. Access shall be provided from the Public Road only and no access is to be provided from the Tucson/Prescott Road, in accordance with the Council's requirements.
- (3) That as part of the total design provisions shall be made for the safe and proper storage of the material to be used in the work.
- (4) That all mining operations shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Mining Act, 1964, and the regulations thereunder.

Conditions for Completion

- (1) In every case the development shall be in accordance with the provisions and stipulations set out in the conditions.
- (2) In the interests of public safety and convenience of traffic the Council may require the development to be completed in accordance with the provisions of the Mining Act, 1964, and the regulations thereunder.
