Agreements of the United States with the Government of the United States

These are the results

General

- (1) That the development of a national system of education in the United States shall be the result of the cooperation of the Federal Government and the States.
- (2) That the Federal Government shall be authorized to contribute to the cost of such a system.
- (3) That the Federal Government shall be authorized to contribute to the cost of such a system.

Provision for the States

- (1) The Federal Government shall be authorized to contribute to the cost of such a system.
- (2) In the event of a national emergency, the Federal Government shall be authorized to contribute to the cost of such a system.
- (3) In order to carry out the provisions of this Act, the Federal Government shall be authorized to contribute to the cost of such a system.
