In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order TP/2800/65 dated 3/2/1966 make a decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act to grant an outline permission for:

Industrial development at Ballymount Road

subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) That no constructional work take place until detailed drawings have been submitted to and approved by the Council under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963.
