- (1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
- (2) That the buildings be set back not less than 30-ft. from the road boundary.
- (3) That details of the construction and location of the septic tanks be approved by the Council's Sanitary Department before work is commenced.
- (4) That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
