Commitments

- (1) That the development is carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications lodged with the applicant;
- (2) That the requirements of the Council's bye-laws are observed in the development;
- (3) That all-roads are provided upon the site and that all other roads are provided within the curtilage of the site;
- (4) That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council;
- (5) That the external fixtures, including the roof, windows in exterior and balconies with the enclosing building.

(6) That building bye-laws approved shall be observed and any modifications of such bye-laws shall be observed in the development.

Conditions for certificate

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the plans and specifications lodged with the applicant;
- (2) In the interests of public safety and convenience of the public;
- (3) In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area;
- (4) In order to comply with statutory provisions relating to the development;
- (5) In the interests of visual amenity.
