Development at Site No. 2 of Junction of Highway Road with Dutchfield Avenue

Plan No. (Site No. 2) - 2,000 sq. ft.

Conditions

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications lodged with the application, save as to the conditions hereinafter otherwise specified.
- (2) That the proposed development be situated on the plot fronting to Highway Road as indicated on the development plan.
- (3) That the necessary land be reserved for road improvement purposes, as indicated in blue on the attached C.P. 513.
- (4) That the external finish, including the work, terminate in colour and texture with the adjoining development.
- (5) That the boundary line be set back not less than 30ft from the road boundary.
- (6) That "utilitarian" purposes only shall be permitted and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for Conditions

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the jurisdiction and effective control authorities.
