Conditions:

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is herein stipulated otherwise required.
- (2) That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
- (3) That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer be adhered to in the development.
- (4) That any revisions to the layout or proposed buildings, consequent on the Council's Fire Officer's requirements, be submitted to and approved by the County Council before any constructional work takes place.

- (5) That any necessary land required for the Council's future road improvement works, which are likely to affect the site at the east corner, be reserved as such.
- (6) That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for conditions:

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
- (2) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
- (3) In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
