Conditions

Reasons for Cancellation

- (1) That the development be carried out strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications lodged with the applicant.
- (2) That the drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
- (3) That the design, location of the proposed main tanks together with the proposed water supply arrangements be agreed with and approved by the Health Department, Waterworks Dept., before any construction work is put in hand.
- (4) That all other statutory requirements shall be observed and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the provisions and effect of current legislation.
- (2) In order to comply with Statutory provisions (Act, 1974 - 1974).
- (3) In the interests of public health and in order to protect the environment from any possible contamination.
