In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District dated 10th Feb. 1967 make a of Dublin, did by order P/1160/66 decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act refusing outline permission for:

Development including Motel, Service Garage and Bedroom Chalet Units

at Kingswood, Clondalkin

for the following reasons:-

- (I) Development of the kind proposed would be premature by reference to the existing deficiency in the provision of water supplies and sewerage facilities and the period within such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- (2) In the absence of piped water and drainagesservices the proposed work would endanger the health of persons occupying or employed in the proposed structures and would also be prejudicial to public health, because the estimated daily consumption of water would be approximately 8,000 gallons. There is no space provided on the site for the soakage of this amount of water even if the ground was suitable for that purpose.
