**Water and power filling station at Simpson's Nose Road**

- (1) The proposed development immediately adjoining the Industrial Junction on the Main Road Road dual-carriageway is likely to cause obstruction to traffic flow due to subtraction of road capacity by developments and would create serious traffic hazards.
- (2) Development of the kind proposed would be premature by reference to the existing deficiency in the provision of sewage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- (3) In the absence of piped drainage services the proposed work would endanger the health of persons occupying or employed in the proposed structures and would also be prejudicial to public health, because the estimated daily consumption of water would be approximately 8,000 gallons. Adequate supply has not been provided on the site for the volume of this amount of water even if the groundwater is suitable for that purpose.
- (4) The proposed development would seriously injure the sanitation of the adjoining residential area.
