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Factory at Keshik, Nugh Bani, Classindia

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications lodged with the applicant, save as to the conditions hereunder otherwise required. (In the interests of proper planning and development).
- (2) That on-site car parking spaces be provided for not less than 15-cars, in order to serve the proposed development.
- (3) That a suitable screen of trees be planted along the fringe of the site in addition to that shown along the western side of the factory plot. (In order to preserve amenity).
- (4) That the factory shall not be used other than as a light industrial building as defined in the Local Government (Planning and Development), Act, 1963, (Amended Development Regulations, 1964).
- (5) That adequate internal and external fire fighting equipment, in accordance with the fire fighting regulations of the Dublin County Council, be provided in the development. (In the interest of safety).
- (6) That building bye-law approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
