Conditions

Reasons for refusal

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications lodged with the application and as in the conditions hereunder otherwise also required.
- (2) That regard be had to the limitations imposed by the condition of the Ministry's public permission granted by order, dated 10th June, 1966, in respect of the quantity of average effluent and the capacity of the treatment tank (5,000 gallons per day) on the proposed number of employees in the factory.
- (3) That the representatives of the Council's public permission be satisfied with the plans to be in the development.

- (4) That the national health conditions in which the development is to be carried out are satisfactory.
- (5) That building approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permitted and effective control maintained.
- (2) In order to regulate the discharge of effluent into the existing public sewer in the interests of public health.
- (3) In the interests of public health and safety.
- (4) In the interests of public health and safety.
- (5) In order to comply with Building Regulations Act, 1971 - 1972.
