Conditions

- (1) That the development be carried out strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications lodged with the application.
- (2) That the drainage arrangements, particularly in regard to construction and siting of the septic tank be in accordance with the requirements of the statutory authority.
- (3) That building bye-law approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Requirements for Conditions

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the provisions and effective control maintained.
- (2) To prevent pollution of the adjoining streams with consequent danger to public health.
