**ORDER:** In accordance with the recommendation of the Principal Officer, I decide that having regard to the provisions which are included in the Development Plan, the above proposal would be consistent with proper planning and development and I, therefore, decide TO GRANT **permission** therefor under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963/76 subject to the following conditions imposed for the reasons stated.

**Conditions**

**Reasons for Conditions**

1. The development to be carried out in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

**To comply with permission regulations.**

2. The applicants to make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance repair and upkeep of the structure at their own expense.

**In the interest of amenity and public safety.**

3. The applicants shall accept responsibility for the removal of the structure at their own expense if such is necessary for the purposes of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair replacement and removal of any services installed on the public street.

**In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.**

4. The lighting of the panels to be carried out so as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of adjoining street lights.

**In the interest of public safety and amenity.**

5. The following requirements of the Engineering Department (Roads Section) to be complied with in the development:-

**To achieve a satisfactory standard of development.**

a) there must be no end panels in shelter as otherwise the footpath would be reduced in width below 6ft. at that point.

b) glass in the shelter to be of armoured unbreakable type in order to avoid hazard to pedestrians and other road users.

c) the shelter to be kept to back of footpath.
