<u>DECISION:</u> Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, <u>outline permission is hereby refused</u> for the erection of the said three houses for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE

1. The proposed development would materially contravene condition number 20 of the planning authority's grant of permission dated 16th June, 1978, (Planning Register Reference Number: R.A. 622 refers). This condition which is considered reasonable required that no houses should be erected on land designated as public open space of which the present site forms part.

 There are no public sewerage facilities available to serve the proposed development which accordingly would be premature by reference to this deficiency and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
