- 1. The site of the proposed development is situated in an area soned 'R' "to preserve open space amenity" and 'T' "to provide for recreational open space and ancillary structures" in the 1972 Development Plan. The proposed development would be in conflict with those objectives and would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area and seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.
